HIJACK BYEJACK is the MSCA vehicle light armoring package solution. It is aimed for protecting passengers against car hijackers with hand guns.

- Vehicle fully armored in 4-6 days
- Light weight armoring added to vehicle's body
- Car's original design is preserved internally and externally

The HIJACK BYEJACK armoring package (level IIA protection) consists of the following:

- 1. Light weight Bullet Resistant Glass
- 2. Multiple Layers of Aramid Fibers retrofitted in Doors

Both glass and door armoring are designed to stop multiple impacts of a 9mm parabellum of 8g.

The armored car will also offer protection from forceful blows with stones, hammer and other blunt objects.









STEP ONE: GLASS: STOPGUN® 12


The high ballistic performing STOPGUN® glass is NIJ II A Certified in accordance to Internation stanadards. It has the capacity to stop 6 impacts from a 38 caliber Special and 5 impacts from a 9 mm Parabellum of 8g at 380 M/S, as well as affording protection from forceful blows with stones, hammers and other blunt objects.

The STOPGUN® technology is manufactured by AGP (American Glass Products) based on a formula of high quality and meticulous selection of materials. The result is a superior quality glass that will not generate splinters upon impact and therefore reducing the risk of cuts from glass fragments.

Due to it's low thickness (only 12mm), the glass is easily installed and is readily adaptable with simple imperceptible modifications to the chassis and will also not interfere with any of the car's antennas and sensors. This adaptation can be later reversed to the original glass in case the protection is no longer required.










STEP TWO: DOORS: TWARON® ARAMID FIBERS

Multipe layers of TWARON® are custom designed to fit inside the vehicles doors. Additional layers of Aramid fiber are also installed behind the backseats to provide additional passenger protection.

TWARON® is an Aramid Fiber (aromatic polymide) manufacured by Teiljin Aramid GMBH in Germany. The aramid Fiber is not only light wieght but it also provides impact resistance and energy absorption properties.



TWARON® Characteristics:

- High strength (excellent strength-to-weight properties)
- High dimensional stability
- Excellent heat, cut and chemical resistance
- Non-conductivity
- No melting point (degradation only starts at 500°C)







Most Popular car hijacking spots:

- · In parking areas
- · At traffic light
- In front of private residences
- In lonely areas

Steps to prevent car hijack:

- · Lock all doors and windows before driving off
- Try to vary your route to all places you go regularly.
- Keep your eyes open for anything out of the ordinary
- Ensure all your mirrors are adjusted to give you an optimal all-round view or your surroundings.
- Be familiar with your environment and get to know who is surrounding your home, workplace and who does not.
- Try to stop about 5m behind a car in front of you at a stop sign or traffic light –
 it makes for an easy getaway if trouble arises.
- When at a traffic light, keep a few feet of distance between your car and the one ahead of you.

 That way, if a person approaches your car with ill intent, you can pull out of the lane and drive away.






Don't:

- Don't drive with your car window more than 5 cm open.
- Avoid going to petrol stations after 9 pm.
- Don't open your vehicle window or door to strangers.
- Never reach for your handbag if you've been ordered out of your car.
- Don't enter your garage or a parking area if you believe you are being followed.

 Drive to the nearest police station.
- Don't leave your car door open and the engine running while opening your garage door or gates criminals can act quicker than you'd expect.
- Don't be distracted by people handing out flyers at intersections or buy items, such as flowers and newspapers, from unfamiliar vendors.

Your hijack safety plan





Do:

- Remain in your car if it is hit from behind.
 Inspect any damage only once you are sure it is not a hijack attempt.
- Always put your bag under the passenger seat or in the boot.
- Attract the attention of other motorists or pedestrians if you think you are in danger. You can use the flash lights, put your emergency lights on or shout.
- If you suspect that you are being followed, you should ideally drive to the nearest police station. If this is not possible, drive to another safe place but don't go home.
- If approached by a suspicious-looking person, especially at night or in lonely areas, drive off quickly from a stop street or intersection, always heeding traffic danger.

Possessions can be replaced, a life cannot. Your life is worth more than your vehicle!
